Join us for a day of exploring local agriculture!

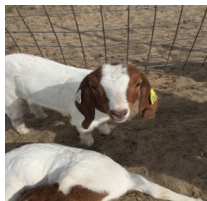
**Thursday, July 6 Youth Berry Day** – Pick blueberries at a local berry farm, then visit a circa 1880's farm to learn about the Longleaf Pine fire-dependent ecosystem.



**Thursday, July 20 Peach Day** – visit a local farm raising cattle and growing organic vegetables; pick peaches and eat peach ice-cream!



**Thursday July 27 God's Garden and Goats!** Visit a local Church's produce "garden" where they grow for area food banks. Pick and eat watermelon and watch green beans picked with a large mechanical harvester! Visit a goat farm that raises goat used in regional 4-H goat clubs.



Register for each day by calling your local Extension office: Moore (910.947.3188), Richmond (910.997.8255) or Montgomery (910.576.6011). **Deadline to register is the Monday before the tour.** However, van space is limited so register early! **Cost is \$5.** Bring a bag lunch. Drinks will be provided.

Dress appropriately for a day on the farm (**close toed shoes a must!**)
