



2018 4-H Summer Fun

Classes Begin June 11!

4-H Summer Fun is a series of educational activities designed to make the most of summer vacation. Summer Fun encourages youth to learn with productive activities that are FUN! Prior 4-H Membership is NOT required to participate in Summer Fun.

Registration

All classes are filled on a first come, first basis

Summer Fun Registration will begin at 9 a.m. on April 23rd. Registration will remain open until all camps and classes are full. **2018 Summer Fun classes are open to Richmond County youth ages 10-13. ALL classes will be Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. until 4 p.m. and require a bag lunch. Each week will cost \$50 per child with only 15 children accepted for each week.** Registration will NOT be accepted, nor will spaces be held, by mail or over the phone. To register, please bring ALL COMPLETED FORMS with payment to the Extension Office at 123 Caroline Street in Rockingham.

Payment for day classes are due at the time of registration. Payments can be made with cash (**correct change only**), money order or check (preferred) made to Richmond County 4-H. Registration Forms will **NOT** be accepted without payment. **ALL FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE**, unless we make a schedule or class change!

No refunds will be given for Summer Fun programs except in the event of a cancellation by our office. We will not be able to prorate any classes if your child(ren) can not attend all scheduled days. All refunds will be processed at the conclusion of the entire Summer Fun program in August. Please allow 2 weeks from that time for a check to be requested from the County Finance Department. You will be responsible for ensuring that your child(ren) arrive and are picked up on time for each program. If you are late for any field trips, we will not be able to wait and no refunds will be issued. In the event you will not be able to attend class, please notify 4-H immediately. This will give another child on the class waiting list the opportunity to attend class.

Guidelines

All classes will meet at the Richmond County Extension Office, 123 Caroline Street in Rockingham. To help us prepare and plan, please drop off/pick up your child within 10 minutes of start/end time. You **MUST** enter the building with your child to drop them off and pick them up. Children will not be able to leave the classroom without an adult.

Youth should wear clothing that is comfortable for a lot of moving and can get dirty. Remember, we are having FUN! Youth should also bring sunscreen for outside activities. Sunscreen in a spray /aerosol will work the best to cover kids quickly.

Snacks and juice/bottled water will be provided for all programs. Please note that a bagged lunch is required daily. Please note any special dietary needs on your medical release forms. Please Review the 4-H Code of Conduct with your child(ren). We reserve the right to suspend your child from the program should he/she become disruptive or violate the 4-H Code of Conduct in any way. If a child must be dismissed from the program, then the parent/guardian will be called to pick up the child IMMEDIATELY.

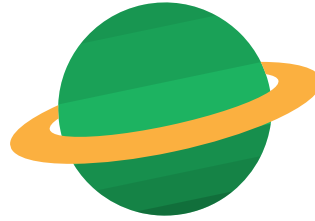
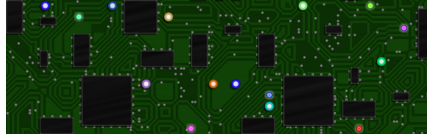
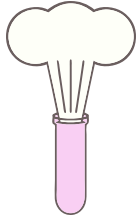

June 11-15

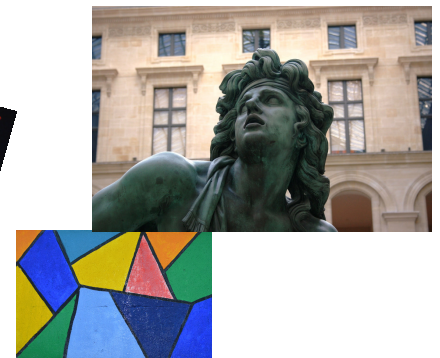
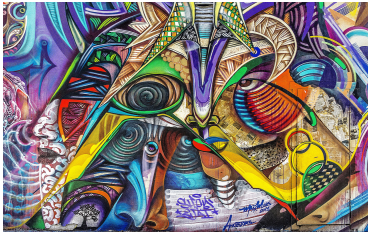

June 25-29

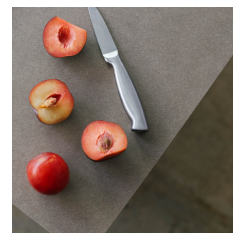

July 16-20

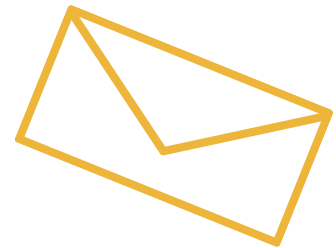

July 23-27

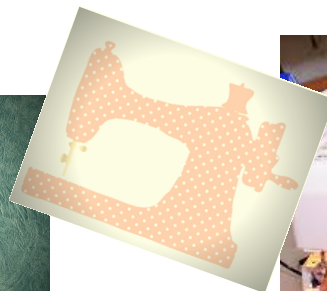
